
INFORMATION FOR BANDS VISITING BICKINGTON CHURCH

THE CHURCH

The Church is in the centre of what is a very small village You would struggle to get a Coach up towards the Church, but can use the bus stop by the junction on the main road and walk the short distance up to the Church. If travelling by car then there is a village hall opposite the Church, you may park there as long as the hall is not in use, otherwise you will need to park on the road.



THE BELLS

There are 6 Bells in the tower at Bickington which form a pleasant light six with a tenor of just over 7 Cwt the bells go well but there is a long draught and particularly the front two can be a little flighty.

TOILETS

There are no toilets in the Church or nearby

LOCAL PUB AND OTHER FACILITIES

The nearest pub is the Welcome Stranger about a mile away which does very good food and good beer there is also the Star Inn at Liverton.

DISABLED ACCESS

There are a couple of steps down into the Church and a couple of steps at the back of the Church to where you ring. There are ramps behind the door to assist with wheel chair access.
